The show was set to be held at the Ricoh Arena next June with new branding and a refreshed concept but due to the instability of the economic European road map, this very hard decision has had to be made.

This is not to say the show won't be back but for 2019 but the firm decision was made by the Brintex and Hemming Group Board to put the show on hold.
